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U. Heid is a professor of computational linguistics and language technology at University of Hildesheim, since 2010. Since 1990, he had been responsible for research projects in applied natural language processing, at Institut für maschinelle Sprachverarbeitung of Universität Stuttgart. He got his PhD and his “habilitation” in Stuttgart. His research interests, including current projects, concern electronic dictionaries, terminology processing and tools for as well as applications of corpus linguistics in the Digital Humanities. He is a co-editor of the recent handbook on (computational) lexicography, HSK-5/4, of the yearbook “Lexicographica” and of the accompanying book series “Lexicographica Series maior”. Recent projects include basic research in corpus linguistics (in the Stuttgart special Research Centre SFB-732, 2006-11), applied research in terminology processing (EU project TTC 2010-2012) and ongoing cooperations with industry) and design studies for electronic dictionaries. He has been interested in corpus-based work on multiword expressions since the 1990s.
