Jean-Pierre Colson is professor of Translation Studies and Linguistics and President of the Louvain School of Translation and Interpreting (LSTI). He received his PhD in Linguistics at the University of Louvain in 1988, and has been teaching and working since then within the fields of foreign language learning, translating and interpreting, and linguistics. He is a member of the Advisory Council of the European Society for Phraseology (Europhras), in which organisation he has been playing an active role for many years. He has international expertise in the area of the corpus-based and computational aspects of phraseology. He is also the Managing Editor of the leading scientific journal on phraseology, the Yearbook of Phraseology (Mouton de Gruyter). He has published more than 70 scientific papers, contributions or books on the subject of contrastive linguistics, phraseology, translation studies, corpus and computational linguistics.
